Starting the year on a HIGH note? Do it safely!

Falls from height are one of the most frequent causes of workplace fatalities.

Some basic guidelines for safety while "Working at Height":

Wherever possible, use an existing place of work that is already safe, e.g. a nonfragile roof with a permanent perimeter guardrail

Use collective protection work equipment to prevent people from falling, e.g. mobile elevating work platforms (MEWPs) such as scissor lifts and tower scaffolds

Use a work restraint (travel restriction) system that prevents a worker getting into a fall position
